



TEMPERATURE MEASUREMENT STEPS UPON ENTERING THE SCHOOL FACILITIES

All persons entering the school facility should get their temperature measured by designated staff and follow the steps below:

- Before using the infrared thermometer, it is advisable to acclimatize it to the place where the temperature will be taken. This is to take it to the place where the measurement will be performed and switch it on for at least 10 minutes before starting the measurement.
- Make sure that physical distance (2 meters) is kept between one person and another.
- Ask the person who will take the temperature measurement to stay still while the measure occurs.
- When using the infrared thermometer, point to the top of the hand of the person who is taking the temperature.
- Verify the temperature indicated by the thermometer, ensuring that it was taken correctly.
- Indicate the result of the measurement to the person.
- Remember that the average temperature ranges between 36.5°C and 37.5°C.

Important: When taking temperature measurements, avoid having mobile devices in operation nearby.
